Prayer

Building & Grounds – HVAC

Pastor Greg reported that for \$3,000 to \$4,000 the Sanctuary HVAC system could be recharged and leaks fixed but there is no guarantee that this would fix the very old system, and if it did, for how long the fix would hold. Discussed options.

MSC to purchase a new HVAC system for the Sanctuary, which will include an electrical heating component rather than gas, and that we will ask the congregation to help fund the project.
