LifeGroup Questions.

1. What obstacles kept Zacchaeus from seeing Jesus in verses 1–4?
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2. Zacchaeus was willing to do something undignified to see Jesus. What does that teach us about the priority of seeking Him?
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3. When Jesus looked up and called Zacchaeus by name, what does that reveal about Jesus' heart and purpose?
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4. Why is it significant that Jesus says, "I must stay at your house today"?
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5. How did the crowd respond when Jesus chose to be a guest in Zacchaeus' home, and what does that reveal about them?
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6. How does this story challenge the way we think about the people Jesus welcomes to His table?
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7. In what ways might God be inviting you to "make room" for someone others overlook?
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SHOPPING LIST

A few ingredients for practicing hospitality this week.

- ☐ Read Luke 19:1–10 this week and thank Jesus for seeking us when we feel unseen.
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- ☐ Invite someone you don't normally sit with to a meal or conversation.
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- ☐ Practice noticing people who may feel on the outside—and make an intentional effort to welcome them.
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- ☐ Before one meal this week, pause to pray that God would show you how to extend His hospitality to others.
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READ & REFLECT

Read Luke 19:1–10 throughout the week.

Reflect on how Jesus seeks us out, makes room for us, and restores us to community. Ask God to help you participate in His mission by showing hospitality that reflects His heart.
